We successfully organized 2nd National Breast Cancer Consensus Conference and Istanbul Breast Conference in October 21-25, 2008 in Istanbul Polat Renaissence Hotel. There were 15 foreign and 100 national breast cancer specialists in this meetings. They gave conferences and share panels. The aims of the conferences were to increase breast health and breast cancer knowledge of our attendances, to figure out the most effective and economic early diagnostic and therapeutic ways for Turkish women with breast cancer. There were 700 participants mostly general surgeons coming from different part of Turkey to the conferences.

Dear readers, we again would like to invite you to participate our first national multicentric prospective clinical trial, MF-07-01. As you know, this study will be the first study in the world on this topic. The open name of the trial is "The effect of surgery as primary therapy on survival in patients with distant metastatic breast cancer." The ongoing trial started one year ago and has more then 20 patients. It also has a national ethical committee decision to participate from all around of Turkey.
